		1. The Spirit of God [Youth Choir]
YM NARRATOR #1: In a world full of noise and distraction with a million voices telling us a million directions to go, the Lord extends a clear and loving invitation to each of us: <i>"Walk with me."</i> YW NARRATOR #1: The Spirit of God is moving across the earth, opening hearts, lifting burdens, and inviting all of us to step onto the covenant path. When we choose to follow Jesus Christ, His Spirit brings light to our minds, peace to our souls, and joy to our daily lives.		

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YW NARRATOR #2: Heavenly Father has given us agency—the power to choose. But we are not left to navigate life alone. God loves us and has provided Jesus Christ to be our guide, our strength, and our light. YM NARRATOR #2: When we use our agency to choose to believe in Christ, we find His power in our life to keep His commandments, honoring our baptismal covenants, and striving to act like Him every single day. When we chose to believe in Christ – to <i>truly</i> believe in Him, we place Him at the center of our lives, and our foundation becomes unshakable.		<i>(after ‘and our light’, START “I Believe in Christ”)</i>

	TESTIMONY #1: Share a brief testimony about choosing to believe and follow Jesus Christ and how His gospel provides daily guidance and strength.	
YM NARRATOR #3: Walking with Christ also means understanding the reality of His Atonement. None of us will navigate mortal life perfectly. We make mistakes, experience heartache, and face trials. YW NARRATOR #3: But the Savior's sacrifice is real. Repentance is not a punishment for failure—it is a joyful opportunity to change, grow, and become cleaner and stronger through Jesus Christ. Because of His infinite grace, we are never beyond His reach.		<i>(after ‘and face trials’, START “I Stand All Amazed”)</i>

	TESTIMONY #2: Share a brief testimony of the Savior's divine love, His healing power, and the peace that comes through repentance.	
YW NARRATOR #4: As we walk with the Savior, our vision of who we are becomes clear. We learn that we are beloved sons and daughters of Heavenly Father, endowed with divine nature and eternal destiny. YM NARRATOR #4: Throughout history, God has called prophets to teach His children this truth. In the spring of 1820, a fourteen-year-old boy named Joseph Smith sought answers in a grove of trees. His humble prayer opened the heavens and restored the fullness of the gospel of Jesus Christ to the earth. Joseph learned what it meant to <i>walk</i> with the Lord.		<i>(after 'a grove of trees', START "Oh, How Lovely Was the Morning")</i>

	TESTIMONY #3: Share a brief testimony of Joseph's courage to follow God's will as the prophet of the restoration.	

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YM NARRATOR #5: Through the Restoration, we are blessed to have the Book of Mormon, modern apostles and prophets, and temple blessings. These divine gifts help us stay on the path back to our heavenly home. YW NARRATOR #5: Walking with Christ isn't just about our own journey—it changes how we treat everyone around us. We are called to love God and love our neighbors. We show our love for the Savior by serving others, standing up for the lonely, and lifting those who are in need. YM NARRATOR #5: Matthew 25 reminds us: <i>"Inasmuch as ye have done it unto one of the least of these my brethren, ye have done it unto me."</i>

	TESTIMONY #4: Share a brief testimony of the joy of serving others.	
YW NARRATOR #6: We are not here by accident. We were reserved for this specific time in the history of the world to be a light, to build the kingdom of God, and to invite all to come unto Christ. YM NARRATOR #6: When we walk with Him, we walk in truth and light - we walk in a way that allows the Spirit to be with us. And we share that truth through both our words and our actions.	—
